Key skills include:

- Structuring a speech: Introduction, Body, Conclusion
- Creating engaging openings and memorable closings
- Using personal stories and examples to support key points
- Building clarity and flow in speaking

## Entry Requirements

Completion of Introduction to Public Speaking or prior experience in speaking to a small group. Learners should feel comfortable delivering a short introduction speech and be ready to develop their speech structuring and storytelling skills.
