Description

Explore the basic skills needed to create professional looking decorations. There is a resource cost of £5.00 per learner, regardless of fee paid or concession. All resources will be provided for the first week and your tutor will discuss with you the tools and requirements for the following week, which means there may also be additional costs.

What will I learn?

This 5/6-week course will provide an opportunity for learners to gain some knowledge, understanding and experience with the basics of cake decorating, including the use of specialised tools, equipment and different techniques, within a safe, fun and comfortable environment.

Learners will build a small portfolio of work that they can recognise their progress and celebrate their achievements.

The emphasis of the course will be on you and your wellbeing, taking time out to be creative and work with others on group and individual projects.

This is an opportunity to spend some time on a new craft, develop a hobby or simply enjoy a mindful activity.
