Description

This course develops independence through engaging project -based learning, while embedding English, maths, and digital skills. Learners will also strengthen essential soft skills such as communication, teamwork, and problem-solving to prepare for future work and study.

Entry Requirements

This course is suitable for learners working at Entry Level 2 - 3 who have previously studied English or maths but are not yet ready to progress to the next level.

This 16-week course develops independence and confidence through exciting project -based learning. By the end of the course, you will have improved your confidence in using skills for real -life and work contexts and be better prepared for your next steps in training, work, or further study.
